

Dressage/Schooling (if you are new to dressage or apprehensive – don't panic!). You can use your session, for example, to learn some schooling exercises, work on your rein handling or work on a dressage test – the choice is yours - whatever your level and experience. **If you would like any specific aspects of driving covered please let us know before the event.**



Cones – there will be a full course to drive allowing you to practice – working on getting the right lines, pace and accuracy.

Over the weekend there will be a round of 21st Century Cones.

Obstacles. – Water, barrels, undulating ground compulsory flags etc. will be available to allow experience of walking and driving these.

Additional sessions may include harnessing – different types of harness; timing and navigation

skills; course design and building; stewarding/judging; the role of the groom and more! All

building on the information you learned at the Hartlebury Training Day.

There will be the opportunity to drive out through Lincomb estate onto quiet country lanes, and there will be a fun competition. To get the most out of the whole weekend your ponies/horses will need to be fairly fit so they too can enjoy the activities

N.B. 2nd turnouts are also welcome.

Bring food for yourself and horses. Fish and chips can be delivered to site on Friday for those who want them. Saturday Evening will be a “do-it-yourself” barbecue – we provide the equipment – you bring your barbecue food and refreshments
