Dear colleagues

It isn't long before Spring Camp so we thought **all members** would welcome an update on what the Committee has planned. We have a good range of turnouts - Rachel Reilly, Dawn Tebbett, Will Amos, Jess Amos, Fliss Newman (juniors), Giselle Lockett, Tony Edwards, Phillip Wright, Simon and Sam Mitchell, Becky Taylor and Julie Wedgbury.

We have taken on board your feedback from the AGM and tried to reflect this as far as possible in the programme.

The programme has a variety of activities based around a set of core training sessions and the option to pick and mix to design a more personalised programme.

Core training consists of:

- a one to one lesson with Andrew Williams on the Saturday - to work on what you want;
- a demonstration of schooling/basic dressage movements driven by one of our club members and facilitated by Andrew - we would like to video this session so we can use it in further training sessions - if there are any members (you don't have to be attending camp) who could video this (Saturday 1700 - 1830 hrs.) we would love to hear from you
- designing and building a cones course and obstacles
- practical driving session (Sunday) driving the cones and obstacles you have built - instructed by Andrew

Pick and Mix - Design Your Own Programme:

- dressage arena for your personal use with the option of help/guidance
- rein handling machines with help/guidance on hand
- long reining area based on gamblers choice
- practice cones area
- drive out on the lower fields and lanes of Lincomb estate

So you will be able to fit in the pick and mix around your lesson and the core training activities

We will also set up a table top sale area where you can bring driving/horse items you wish to sell - label with name and price wanted.

Arrival is from 1400 onwards on Friday and the camp closes about 1530/1600 hours on the Sunday.

The Shed have kindly agreed to provide the food on the Friday night so a menu and price list will be circulated shortly. Saturday evening is a DIY BBQ starting at 1900 hrs. - this is open



to all club members and we would love for colleagues to join us - if you could let Linda know if you wish to attend.

Club members are very welcome to come and watch any part of the camp and indeed we will need helpers so let us know if you can assist - it doesn't have to be the whole day or weekend. So if you are unable, for whatever reason, to participate with a turnout come along and watch/help - a great way of gaining knowledge.

Costs - if you haven't paid your deposit or fee in full please liaise with Linda ASAP - £100. In addition if you want stabling also let Linda know - £15 one night and £10 for second night per stable. If you plan to use your own temporary stabling there is a £10 charge. We have the use of the new clubhouse with catering facilities (kettles, fridges, cooker).

We look forward to seeing Camp turnouts and other club members for what is sure to be a fun and enjoyable camp.
